



I was on a call with my friend Neal in Madagascar when I received this text:

But this time I was eager to help with some simple tips I had JUST LEARNED days prior.




I got off the phone with Neal and called to share what Seth Minton, DO, OB-GYN and his wife Brittany had shared with our Campus Advisors only 5 days ago!

The core of Seth's advice is to allow Mormons/LDS to share their beliefs, especially their answers to these four questions:

1. Who is God
2. Who is Jesus?
3. Who is man?
4. What is salvation?

My mind immediately wondered what all people who call themselves Christians would say to this. Those four questions are so vital to how we live. And how we live probably answers those four questions even better than we could verbally answer them!

Answers fly through my head regarding these questions, but mostly just in the form of Scripture passages: Gen. 1:1; Nu. 23:19; Is. 26:4; 33:22; 64:8; Mt. 28:20 just the first ones that come to mind in answer to the first question.



We shouldn't be surprised when God weaves situations to what we have just learned about Him.
